REGULATIONS

Time and Place of the championship - The World Cup will take place on June 30, 2025 in Batumi, Georgia.

The World Cup consists of six main categories - Boys U8, Girls U8, Boys U10, Girls U10, Boys U12, Girls U12.

Participation - All qualified players can participate in the championship.

Competition Structure - Participants will have 90 minutes to solve 8 compositions (3 two-movers, 3 Three-movers and 2 endgame studies). Each solved composition will be scored with a five-point scoring system.

Winners - The winning places will be determined according to accumulated points. In case of an equal score, the time spent is taken into account.

The boys and girls U12 - June 30 15:00-16:30

The **Results** - The preliminary results will be published at 15:00 on July 1. The results can be appealed in person on the same day at 15:00:18:00. The final results will be published at 20:00 on July 1.

Awarding - The winners will be awarded with cups, golden medals and diplomas. Participants ranked on second and third places will be awarded with medals and diplomas of corresponding quality.
